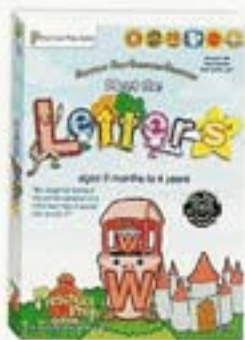


Puttin' On The Ritz
